

## **Tree Pledge & Registration Form**

Please read this form carefully as it spells out your responsibility to your tree.

- 1. I am a resident of Old Saybrook, CT.
- 2. I agree to read all instructions pertaining to planting, watering and mulching my tree. www.sostrees.net/resources
- 3. I commit to appropriate maintenance and care of my tree.
- 4. I agree to watch the Arbor Day Foundation <u>video</u> about planting container trees. The root flare should be at ground level.
- 5. I will not plant my tree between the sidewalk and the street, on any town right of way or over sanitary sewer or septic systems, natural gas, or electric services or under electrical or communication wires.
- 6. I will check for underground utilities at <a href="https://www.cbyd.com">www.cbyd.com</a> or call (800 )922-4455.
- 7. Immediately after planting I will give the tree 2-3 gallons of water as newly planted trees require about 10 gallons of water 3 times per week until the new root becomes established. Water until the ground freezes.
- 8. If I am unable to pick up my tree, I will notify SOS Trees at SOStrees06475@gmail.com
- 9. To help promote building Old Saybrook Tree Canopy please consider taking a photo of your tree and send to SOS Trees for our database.
